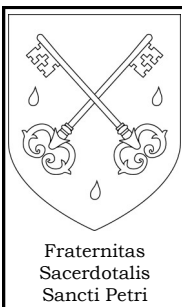

Epiphany Blessing

If anyone still wishes to arrange for an Epiphany blessing of their home, please contact the chaplain by the end of the day today. No more additional requests will be taken after today, Sunday, Jan. 3. You will be contacted a day or two in advance of the blessing, which will take place between Jan. 6 and Jan. 13.

Epiphany Water

We will have the blessing of special Epiphany Water after Mass on Tuesday, Jan. 5. You may bring your own containers of water if you wish to have this water at your homes. Wide-mouthed containers are preferred for the blessing process.

Contribution Statements

If you have made more than \$250 in verifiable (i.e. check or clearly marked envelope) donations to the community in the year 2008, you will automatically receive a statement to that effect as required by the tax laws. Anyone else who would like one has the right to receive a statement, but must make a specific request. The statements should be in the mail at the beginning of the week. If you feel an error has been made in calculation, do not hesitate to contact the chaplain. Also a reminder — since the community does not use an envelope system, if anyone wishes a cash donation to be recorded under their name, please simply put the donation in a plain envelope with your name written clearly on it.
