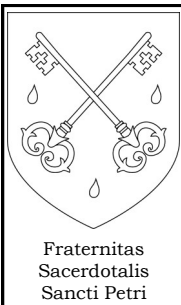

### Volunteers Needed

One can renew the dedication of his home to God for the coming year by writing the following above the outside of the principal entrance of the home: **20 + C + M + B + 10**, in honor of the three kings, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar.
