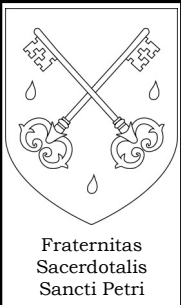

Please Note: Change to Temporary Schedule

Masses are now at **9:00 AM from Monday through Saturday.** Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation remain at Our Lady of the Rosary.
