Moving Again

Beginning Ash Wednesday, Feb. 17, weekday Masses will take place at Holy Cross Church, 1924 Leo Street. Masses are at 9 AM unless otherwise noted in the bulletin. The most notable exception will be during Lent, when Mass on Fridays will be at 7 PM, immediately after Stations of the Cross.

Ash Wednesday

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. We will have High Mass with blessing and imposition of ashes at 7 PM at Holy Cross.

Stations of the Cross

During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross on Friday nights beginning at 6:30 PM with Mass immediately following, except on First Fridays, when the Stations will replace the First Friday devotions after Mass.

Regulations for Lent

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 17. The following are the barest minimum obligations which must be observed by Catholics under pain of serious sin (if there is no serious excusing cause).

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meatless meal. Two smaller meals, not equaling together a full meal, are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
