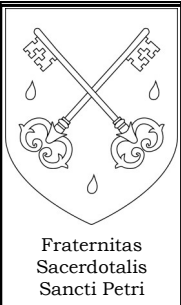

During Lent, we will have Stations of the Cross on Friday nights beginning at 6:30 PM with Mass immediately following, except on First Fridays, when the Stations will replace devotions after Mass.
