Divine Mercy Indulgence

The church grants a plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Sunday after Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honour of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!)"

 Easter Duty

From the Code of Canon Law:

Can. 920 §1. After being initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, each of the faithful is obliged to receive holy communion at least once a year.

§2. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at another time during the year.

Comments: The "Easter season" is considered to stretch from the first Sunday of Lent until the first Sunday after Pentecost (Trinity Sunday). Therefore, Catholics may fulfill this duty at any point within this space of time.

The old obligation to confess one's sins once a year (generally before the Easter Communion) no longer binds. The following law has supplanted it:

Can. 989 After having reached the age of discretion, each member of the faithful is obliged to confess faithfully his or her grave sins at least once a year.

Comments: This is understood to mean that if one has no grave sins to confess, one is not obliged to confess at all, or perhaps stated better, one must confess any grave sins within one year. It is not recommended to confess one's sins only once a year.
