Latin Mass Community Moving
 The community will be moving to Holy Family parish in Dayton (5th Street and Findlay) during the last week of June. The community will cease to exist at that point. All current registered members of the community will automatically become members of Holy Family parish, which will be staffed by the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter and will be devoted to the traditional forms of liturgy.

The last Sunday Mass at Our Lady of the Rosary will take place on June 27. After this, we can begin to move to our new location. Weekday Masses will continue at Holy Cross until June 30, after which point there will be a 3-day hiatus during which there will be no scheduled Masses. The full Sunday and weekday schedule will resume on July 4. Sunday Masses will be at 8:00 AM (Low Mass) and 10:30 AM (High Mass). The weekday schedule will be announced when it has been finalized.
