Moving this week

The community will be moving to Holy Family parish in Dayton (5th Street and Findlay) this week. Weekday Masses will continue at Holy Cross until June 30. The first Masses at Holy Family will be on Sunday, July 4, at 8:00 AM (Low Mass) and 10:30 AM (High Mass). There will be no Masses July 1-3.

parish membership

Due to various canonical and moral issues, the chaplain will have to revise his statement that all registered members of the community will automatically become members of Holy Family Parish. In fact, no one will be automatically made a member of the parish, since this action has to be undertaken voluntarily by the individual, and the pastor must consent. The office of pastor carries with it very serious responsibilities and thus can not be undertaken lightly. According to archdiocesan statutes, the pastor is free to accept or reject any extraterritorial parishioners at his discretion (in fact, no one will live in the territory of Holy Family). There will be certain criteria that must be met in order for an individual to become a canonical member of the parish, which will be outlined after our move. In the meantime, of course, no one is prevented from attending Mass or receiving sacraments at our church. More details will be given after the move.

THE FOLLOWING TASKS STILL NEED TO BE TAKEN OVER:

Sanctuary/Sacristy

Wash, mend, iron altar cloths. (a few times a year)

Wash and iron small altar linens (after priest has performed ritual purifications). About 2 times per month.

Change votive candles and keep stands and glass clean. Once per week, any time during the week.

Church Proper

Clean 2 restrooms, wash floors, sinks, toilets, mirrors and lower walls as needed, empty trash cans and restock soap and paper goods. Once per week, as close to the end of the week as possible.

Keep holy water fonts cleaned and filled. Once per week.

Clean, vacuum and dust the choir loft. Once per month.

Mop all the floors in the church, vestibules and stairs to choir and church hall around the beginning of the month. Sweep the same areas at the middle of the month. May need to be done more often during the snowy weather.

Nazareth Center

Mop floors, general cleaning of all areas, empty trash. 4 times per year or as needed.

Spring cleaning of the entire building. Once per year. (Group effort).

Rectory

Wash rectory windows. 2 times per year.

Clean out rectory gutters. 2 times per year.

Spring clean entire rectory once per year. (Group effort).

(Those living in the rectory will take responsibility for the living spaces)

Exterior Work

Someone to act as a security guard in the parking lot for occasional evening services after dark.
