**DONATIONS** Henceforth, please make your donations payable to Holy Family Church. Such donations are tax-deductible to the extent the law allows. Tax statements for the old community will be forthcoming within the next few months, since there is no rush to issue these. Remember that if you have donated less than \$250 for the current tax year through June 30, you will only receive a statement upon request.

**MONDAY, JULY 5TH**, being a national holiday, morning Mass will be at 9:00 AM.

**REGISTRATION** As mentioned last week, and as you can see in the decree posted on the table at the side entrance, there is currently no one (other than the pastor and the assistant) living within the territory of Holy Family. If anyone wishes to become a parishioner, the pastor must agree this. The pastor does not take this lightly due to the serious canonical obligations that it imposes upon him. If you were a member of the old Latin Mass Community, since all your personal data is on file, you need only ask the pastor for membership verbally, though he would appreciate a written note for his records. However, membership in the old community does not automatically entitle one to membership in the parish. All others must submit registrations anew, even lifetime members of the "old" Holy Family, since we do not have your household data on file. The pastor will make it known to you explicitly, either by word or by publication in this bulletin, that your membership was accepted. At that point, you may notify your territorial pastor that you have changed parishes. There are very few reasons someone might not be accepted as a parishioner, and these will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Registration forms are available at the doors of the church.

**MASS REQUESTS** As always, if you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked "Mass Request" and place it in the collection basket. Alternatively, you can approach a priest or bring or mail the request to the rectory. We do not accept phoned-in or emailed requests. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to the IRS.

**WHERE IS FR. ORŁOWSKI?** It is true that we have been assigned a second priest in order to establish a community in Dayton. However, Fr. Orłowski will not arrive for a few more weeks, as his primary assignment is to cover for other priests in the FSSP, since we are spread very thin across the country and in some places there are few or no priests able to substitute for us. As we grow, and if there is a need in the future, it may be possible to have a second priest full-time. We will have a special welcome for Fr. Orłowski after his arrival.
