#### 18th Sunday After Pentecost

In today's Gospel (MT 9:1-8) we have the healing of the paralytic proving to us that Jesus is God. This is the fundamental dogma of our Catholic faith. All the other dogmas flow from it and anyone who admits this truth has no logical choice but to accept the one true Catholic Church that Jesus Himself founded. It is the Catholic Church to whom He gave the promises: "The gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (MT16:19) and "Know that I am with thee until the consummation of the world!" (MT 28:20). In today's Gospel we see that it was the faith of the sick man's friends climbing on the roof to bring him to Jesus that brought about his healing, first spiritually and then physically: "And Jesus, seeing their faith, said to the paralytic "take courage son, thy sins are forgiven thee."

Let us pray that our faith in our Lord Jesus Christ will continue to grow in us and spread like leaven to all that we meet! In Your kindness please pray for Mr. Bob White who is sick with pancreatic cancer.
