SEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

How appropriate the Sacred Scriptures are for us today during this time after Pentecost. Has the coming of the Holy Ghost into our souls brought forth any good fruit? Have we grown in our faith or have we fallen backwards? St Paul admonishes us in the Epistle, Romans 6:19-23, "But now set free from sin and be slaves to God, you have your fruit unto sanctification and as your end life everlasting. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is life everlasting in Christ Jesus our Lord". In the gospel our Lord gives us the warning: "Every tree that does not bear fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you shall know them. Not everyone who says to me "Lord, Lord" shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of my Father in heaven shall enter the kingdom of heaven." Let us ask ourselves today "Am I doing the will of my Father?" "Am I bearing good fruit?" "Can I do More?" Remember just because we are Catholics—yes even traditional Catholics—does not mean we are going to heaven. Let us do the Father's will every day!

Great Pro Life News!

Right to Life of Northeast Ohio has reported that two Ohio abortion facilities that have a long history of egregious health violations and botched abortions have closed under mysterious circumstances! The closures appear to be voluntary.

The Akron Women’s Medical Group, located in Akron, Ohio, is listed on a Google search as “permanently closed.” This facility conducted surgical and medication abortions.

The Cleveland Women’s Medical Group, was a medication abortion facility that currently states on their website, “This facility has been closed until further notice.” This facility referred surgical abortion patients to the Akron location.

Both clinics had a history of failed safety inspections and botched abortions. **Deo gratias!**

HOWEVER THERE IS ALSO SOME BAD NEWS ABORTIONIST PLANS TO OPEN BIRTH CONTROL BUSINESS IN SUGARCREEK TOWNSHIP

Sugarcreek Township officials confirm that a new “business” is opening in Sugarcreek Township, called “Abby’s Place for Women” in the Sugarcreek Plaza. They will offer birth control prescriptions on site with no physical exam.

The person behind this new business model, is Dr. Timothy Kress. He is a documented abortionist with a long and problematic history. His medical license was revoked in 1999 due to felony drug charges to which he pled guilty. As of October 2016, he was employed at the Planned Parenthood location in Bedford Heights, Ohio. While there he has at least 15 incidents of incomplete chemical abortions requiring follow-up medical abortions.
