Twenty-First Sunday After Pentecost

Today's gospel, MT 18:23-35, is Our Lord's parable about the Merciless Servant. How appropriate—as always—is the Word of God for us today during this Year of Mercy. Our lesson is that God Our King is infinitely merciful! He will forgive ALL our sins if we are truly sorry for them and ASK FOR HIS MERCY. However, He expects us to HAVE MERCY ON OTHERS! "Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy" is one of the beatitudes. In the Our Father we set the limit as to how much we want God to forgive us by how merciful we are to others: "Forgive us our trespasses AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US! Let us therefore be very merciful to others!

The epistle, Eph 6:10-17, is also timely with the upcoming elections. St. Paul reminds us we are not fighting against flesh and blood but "against the world rulers of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness on high. Therefore take up the armor of God". We are in a spiritual battle for the soul of our nation! Be sure to pray and vote!
