

Feast of the Transfiguration August 6th



In today's gospel, MT 17:1-9, Our Lord reveals to SS, Peter, James and John Who He truly is on Mt. Thabor. Peter exclaims "Lord it is good for us to be here." He wants to set up tents so that moment and the company of Jesus in His glory with Moses and Elijah would not end. However, this was only to be a glimpse of Who Jesus truly is because soon He will suffer His Passion and the faith of His apostles will be shaken. The vision was to strengthen their faith and give them hope that the time will come when the ecstacy will not pass but will remain for all eternity.

This vision should also increase our faith and hope in Christ. But let us recall that before Jesus could come into His glory He had to accomplish His mission, He had to suffer first. We don't just attain the beatific vision, WE HAVE TO EARN IT! If we wish to be transfigured, if we want to attain a glorious body that shines like the "Son", if we too wish to dwell with Jesus and all the saints we too must deny ourselves, pick up our cross and follow Him.
