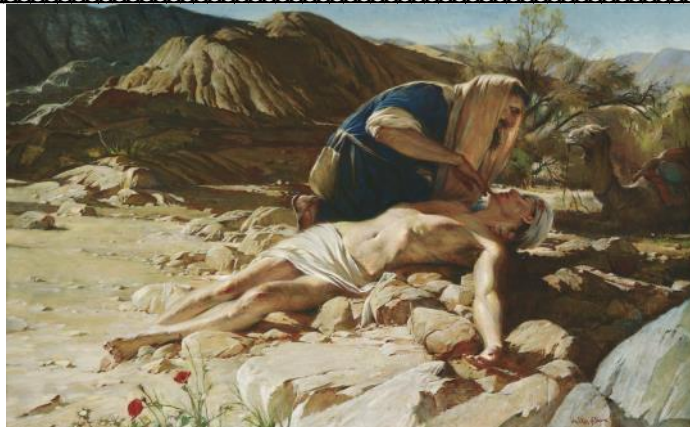

## The Twelfth Sunday After Pentecost

### The Good Samaritan

“What must I do to obtain eternal life?” This is the question asked by the lawyer in today’s gospel. In our secular world many deny the reality of eternal life and the fact that there is indeed an Almighty, Creator God. What are they living for? Let us recall our first catechism lesson: “What is the purpose of man’s existence?” The answer of course is : “ The purpose for our existence is to know, love and serve God in this life so we can be happy with Him forever in the next!” How sad that so many people do not know this fundamental answer. What is their purpose? Our Lord answers the lawyers question with a question “What is written in the Law?” “Thou shall love the Lord thy God with thy whole heart, with thy whole soul, with thy whole strength and with thy whole mind and thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself.” responded the lawyer. To which Jesus affirmed “Do this and thou shall live.” Once we truly know God we will love and serve Him but we must also see Him in our neighbor which can be very difficult! Our Lord gives us the Parable of the Good Samaritan to help us realize that WE were once in the ditch! He saved US! How important to follow His admonition “Go and do thou also in like manner!”
