## **Nineteenth Sunday After Pentecost**

"Be renewed in the spirit of your mind and put on the new man which has been created according to God". These words from the epistle certainly are applicable to their author, St. Paul. In everyone's life there comes a day when we receive a special gift from God-a calling- an invitation. For St. Paul it was on the road to Damascus when Our Lord knocked him off of his high horse and said "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?" Saul answered the call and even changed his name to Paul, the Apostle to the Gentiles and he never looked back! He and all the saints of God were struck by grace and a call to "put on the new man", a call to truly be a creature of God and answer the call to holiness, an invitation they all whole heartedly accepted. They put on Jesus Christ, the New Man par excellence. They began living Christ by seeking the Father's will in everything, by following the commandments, frequenting the sacraments, growing in virtue and by spreading the Gospel of hope to every creature they encountered first of all by example but also by words if needed. And now they possess the infinite joy of the beatific vision—seeing God face to face- for all eternity! In today's gospel we have the parable of the Wedding Feast. This corresponds well with the epistle in that we have ALL been invited, we have ALL been called to live out our baptismal promises. In the parable the king was angry over those who put worldly things as more important than his invitation. Let us not put earthly things above our call to love God! Like St. Paul put on the New Man!


