Please contact the rectory at least six months in advance

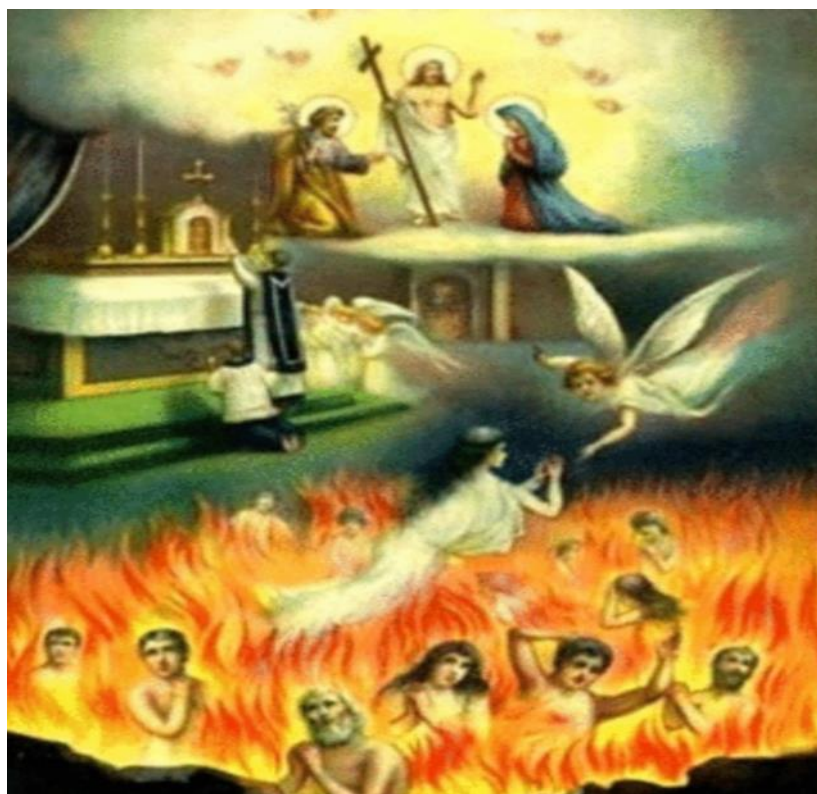

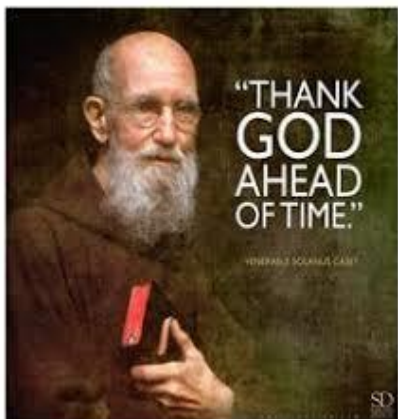

And as if that were not enough to prove His power Jesus then went to the house of Jarius and raised his daughter from the dead! I recall the words of a holy priest who once said "I don't believe in miracles" then after a pause added "I depend on them!" How true for all of us of the Faith!



Ven. Solanus Casey

This Fri., Nov. 18th, Fr. Solanus Casey (1870-1957), will be only the second American born male saint to be beatified. (Bl. Stanley Rother sept 23, 2017, was the first) Fr. Solanus is a modern day saint

proving once again that Holy mother Church continues, with the help of the sacraments, to produce saints. Many are alive today who spoke with him including my own mother when he was living in the Capuchin monastery in Huntington, IN. She had asked him to pray for her sister who was having a problem pregnancy. He simply told her "I think it will be okay. Just say an Our Father and Hail Mary in thanksgiving." The next day the baby within the wound was found to be normal. One of my aunt's 16 children! Fr. Solanus had such great faith he thanked God for miracles that had not yet occurred. Let us have that kind of Faith!!
