FEAST OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD

Today's Mass extols the efficacy of the Precious Blood of Jesus which He shed so generously for us. It commemorates all the times Our Lord poured forth His Most Precious Blood beginning when He was only 8 years old at the circumcision and extending throughout His holy life. It seeped through His pores during the Agony in the Garden. It was poured out profusely during the scourging at the pillar. It ran down His sacred head at the crowning of thorns. And as we read in St. John's eyewitness account it flowed out from the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Holy of Holies, when He was pierced by the lance of St. Longinus at the crucifixion.

On this great feast of the Precious Blood and throughout the month of July which is dedicated to It, let us give great thanks to Our dear Lord who has continued to daily offer up that same Precious Blood for nearly 2000 years in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on all the altars throughout the world! It is also offered up to wash away our sins in the sacrament of penance! In the epistle today St. Paul reminds us that the blood covenant of the Old Testament that God made with Moses and His Chosen people, including the blood of the paschal lamb that was offered up and sprinkled on the doorposts of the Hebrew homes sparing their firstborn from the terrible Angel of Death was but a symbol of the efficacy of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, which has freed us from eternal death and has opened the doors of heaven, our true and everlasting home. 'Know that you were not redeemed with corruptible things as gold and silver from your vain conversation of the tradition of your fathers but with the Precious Blood of Christ!' (1 Peter 1:18). Let us therefore always be mindful of and thank Our Lord Jesus Christ for the most precious gift of His Blood. Let us continue to ask Him today that His Blood be not poured out in vain for our souls nor the soul of our nation!

How important are judges??

Several decisions over the past 15 days have definitively illustrated the importance of judges in our fight for LIFE! Let's start with last week's 6th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals agreeing to hear arguments regarding the 2016 Ohio legislation on abortion funding. If you remember---in February 2016, Ohio lawmakers passed and Governor Kasich signed House Bill 294 which redirects state administered grants - approximately \$1.3 million - away from Planned Parenthood and other abortion providers in the state of Ohio. (States are permitted by federal law to withhold federal family planning dollars from facilities that provide abortion. These funds did not affect reimbursements from Medicaid.) By May 2016, Planned Parenthood of Ohio and Planned Parenthood of Southwest Ohio (which operates in Dayton and has a surgical abortion site in Cincinnati) filed suit in federal court to block the law from being enforced, and consequently the law was found unconstitutional by Judge Timothy Black.

Later, a 3-judge panel of the 6th Circuit Court of Appeals upheld the ruling. Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine appealed the decision in April of this year. Last Thursday, the full 16-member court agreed to re-consider the law. Of note, 4 of the 16 judges have been added under the Trump presidency. "Our hope is that this Court will side with the people of Ohio in determining the distribution of their own tax dollars. Ohioans want better for our women and children," says Margie Christie, Director of Advocacy for Dayton Right to Life. According to LifeNews.com, Pollsters found 64 percent of Ohioans believe that Congress should end taxpayer funding to Planned Parenthood, which received more than \$528 million in taxpayer funding in 2014.

Lastly, our local court case involving Women's Med Center (in Kettering) vs State of Ohio Department of Health, still sits in the court of Judge Mary Wiseman. In December 2016, Judge Wiseman granted a stay for this abortion facility to stay open while she "decides" on its future. In that time, over 2,900 children have lost their lives at 1401 Stroop Road while she "considers" the case. That's more than the combined enrollments of our 4 Catholic high schools in the area. Judges matter!
