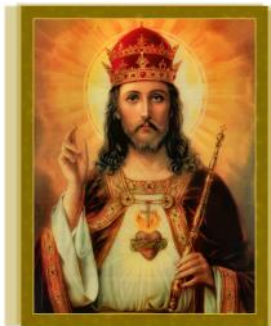

Why No Organ?

After the choir completed its 2017-2018 season on June 29th, the choir director informed me that the choir is very cramped and is already beyond comfortable space capacity. This is a good problem to have but still something must be done! At first we envisioned simply moving the center part of the wall back and adding risers. To my amazement a reputable contractor was found who could possibly do the small project and be done before the next choir season begins in September! After contacting various professionals such as Fr. Lutz of the Jubilee Museum, we were informed that the old pipe organ wind chest behind the choir wall was obsolete (the actual pipe organ has been gone for years) and the newer technology is not only better but also less expensive to maintain. With the help of the Knights of Columbus we have therefore removed the wind chest and pipes. In order to do this we had to disconnect the Digital organ which we have currently been using and will continue to use. It is an exceptional digital organ and expected to last at least another 20 years. However, since some have expressed a desire to have a more extensive remodel than the first, more simple project we have decided to take a more thorough look as to what can be done to 1) maximize capacity of choir space 2) maximize musical output of organ/speakers 3) maintain and improve beauty of choir loft and the beautiful stain glass rose window. Organ will be re-connected for Assumption . More info later.

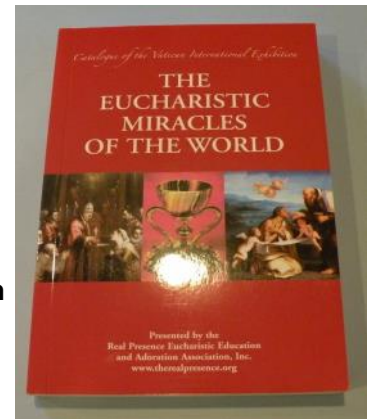
Eucharistic Miracles Display at Holy Family!
