Please pray for God to intervene in the upcoming hearing to be held before Judge Mary Wiseman this coming Friday, August 17th regarding the status of the abortion mill. The case involves Martin Haskell's challenge to the denial of licensure for the Women's Medical Center in Kettering. He has been permitted by the courts to continue operating his abortion business for the past 20 months despite not meeting the requirements for licensure by the Ohio Department of Health. Oral arguments will be heard from both sides as to whether this case is compatible with the ruling made regarding the Toledo abortion mill. The Toledo mill was closed recently, but later reopened after making adjustments to their variance agreement.
