EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Today's Gospel, MT 9:1-8, the healing of the paralytic lying on his pallet, proves to us conclusively that Our Lord, Jesus Christ, truly was and IS—God. This is the fundamental dogma of our Catholic Faith. All other dogmas flow from it and anyone who admits this truth has no logical choice but to accept and follow the One True, Catholic Church that He Himself founded. It is the Catholic Church that received the promises: “The gates of hell shall not prevail against it” (MT16:19) and “Know that I am with you until the consummation of the world” (MT28:20). In today's Gospel we see that it was the faith of the paralytic's friends that brought Jesus to heal him. First spiritually and then physically. “And Jesus SEEING THEIR FAITH said to the paralytic ‘take courage son, thy sins are forgiven thee’”.

May we be true friends by bringing others to Christ. Let us also realize who this Jesus is—HE IS GOD!

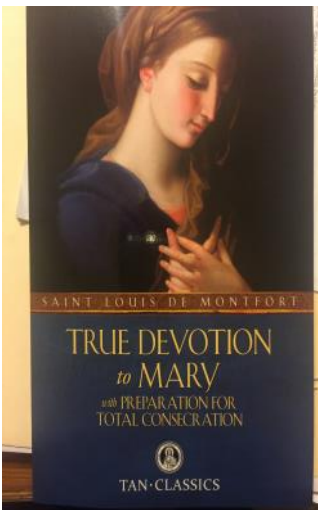
