NINETEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

In today's epistle St Paul quotes psalm 4, verse 5, stating "Be angry and do not sin. Do not let the sun go down upon your anger. Do not give place to the devil". We must first realize that anger in itself is an emotion. It is one of the passions of man. Passions in the Aristotelian sense of the word are entirely sense operations, things that move the will to do something. In this sense they are neither good nor bad and can be found in every man, even in Christ Himself as was evidenced when He threw the moneychangers out of the temple. His zeal for His Father's house moved Him to be angry, a righteous anger, against evil. This is what St. Paul is referring to today. We should be angry at evil. We can't let evildoers get away with hurting ourselves or others but at the same time we cannot over do it, nor hate the person. Our Catholic principle is "LOVE THE SIN-NER BUT HATE THE SIN". For if we hate the person we fall into the vice of anger which is one of the capital sins. Jesus did not kill any of the moneychangers, He did not hate them but what they were doing. Anger caused Him to move within right reason-not too much but not too little either. Let us remember this : Hate the sin but love the sinner! First Friday /First Saturday This Week!


First Friday begins with confessions at 6:30 PM. First Saturday begins at 8AM with exposition/rosary/confessions/private prayer. Mass at 9.
