Today, the last Sunday of October, is the Feast of Christ the King. This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 in an attempt to stem the tide of secular humanism that grew out of the so called "enlightenment" of the 18th and 19th centuries which sees man as the center of the universe who creates "god" in his own image and likeness. Secular Humanism is therefore a way of life that leaves God out of man's thinking and living, organizing one's life as if God did not exist. This feast by which we as Catholics proclaim our fidelity and love to such a gracious King is therefore intended to protect us from such heresy which actually dates back to our first parents and that first lie of the ancient serpent to Eve which caused the eviction of mankind from the Garden of Eden "you too shall be like gods".
