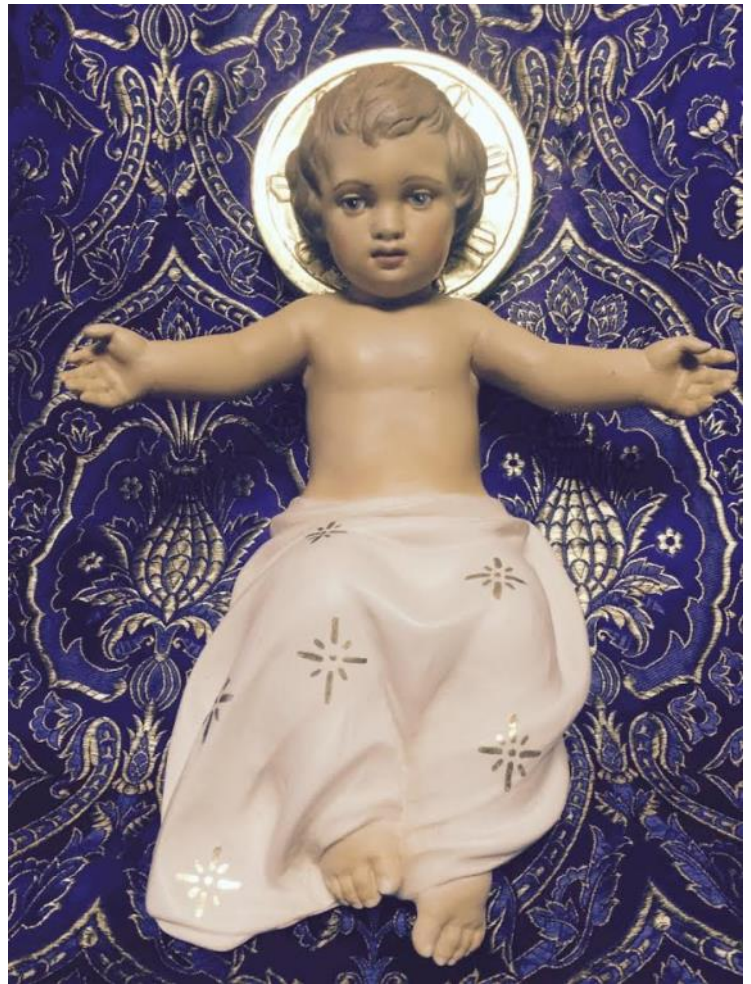

## *Wise Men Still Seek HIM!*



“Where is He that is born King of the Jews?” The word “Epiphany” means ‘manifestation’. For today we see the Christ Child being manifested not only to the Jewish shepherds as on Christmas but also to the Gentiles, the magi, who have seen the magnificent star and have come to bring Him gifts. The epistle from Isaias recounts the prophecy made of Him long ago but which is fulfilled most perfectly. He is the light not just to the Jews but to ALL nations. With His birth salvation history takes a turn for the better. The Light has come and shown through the darkness! The promised Messiah is born who shall redeem His people from sin and through His death and resurrection shall reopen the gates of heaven that were closed since the fall of the first Adam. The new Adam has come as promised. Born of a virgin as the same prophet Isaias had foretold centuries previous.

What was that star that was so splendid the magi would put down their work, leave their comfortable home and families bringing precious gifts and start out on a perilous journey to Israel? How confused they must have been to arrive at the palace of King Herod and find no child there. But leaving Herod they saw the star again and “with exceedingly great joy” followed it to a lowly stable. Again what great confusion when they arrived at a stable—not a palace—and they found the Babe with His Mother. What did they see that they immediately fell down and adored Him? There was no doubt for they laid their gifts before Him. Gold for the great King. Frankincense for the High Priest and Myrrh, a spice used for burial, in preparation for the death of this Child which will bring salvation to all mankind who also proclaim Him King. The story does not end here for it is just the beginning. The Sacred Heart of the Christ Child which called the shepherds and the magi also calls you TODAY. What gifts will you bring the King of Kings? **COME LET US ADORE HIM!**
