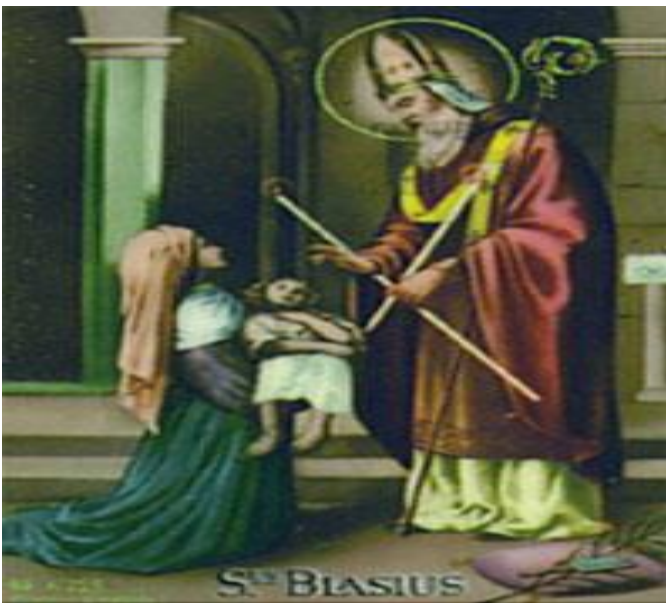
ABUNDANTLY!
