How disappointing to see that the Dayton City Comission actually asked Premier Health to grant Haskel and the Kettering abortion facility transfer rights so abortions could be continued indefinitely! Fortunately, Premier Health did not grant that privilege. The case now goes before the Ohio Supreme Court .

Meanwhile on the national level Alabama Gov. signed a bill into law that may indeed challenge Roe V. Wade US Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion . Let us pray to Our Blessed Mother during May to intercede on behalf of the unborn and of vulnerable mothers as well as for our society both local and national that they will become abortion free zones with the end of legal killing of inno-
