HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY!




Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity expressing the dogma that in the One God there are three Divine Persons: Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Although this is indeed a mystery we are able to believe it without error because God has Himself, He who can neither deceive nor be deceived, revealed it to us. St. Thomas Aquinas explains this Mystery to the best of human understanding in the Summa Theologica, Prima pars, questions 27-43. He also shows us it is reasonable to believe that the Creator God is far beyond what we as creatures know or understand. Praise the Holy Trinity, the Undivided Unity!
