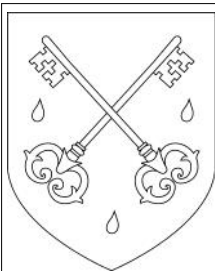

## The Miracle of the Sun!

In today's Gospel Our Lord worked a miracle healing a paralytic saying "Arise, take up thy pallet and go to thy house". A miracle is a phenomenon in nature that can be seen by the senses and is outside the ordinary law of nature brought about by God. 102 years ago today God allowed the Miracle of the Sun that Our lady of Fatima predicted and over 70000 people witnessed! In a rain soaked Cova da Iria in Fatima, Lucia pointed to the sky and shouted "Look!" The sun began changing colors, then started spinning like a wheel. To the horror of all it then appeared to detach from its place and coming falling towards the earth. People cried for mercy thinking it was the end of the world. But suddenly the sun returned to its place and the ground and all the people were perfectly dry though moments before they had been drenched by the rain. Even the socialist newspapers that wanted to defame the children and the Catholic Church had to report what they saw. This gave credibility to the message of Fatima: to stop sinning, PRAY THE ROSARY and do penance for sins! This is the Peace Plan from heaven!
