

#### **Concealed Carry Policy state/archdiocese/Parish**

Regarding Church Buildings: The Ohio State law provides that <u>a concealed handgun may not be</u> <u>carried into any church or other place of worship</u> <u>unless the church or other place of worship per-</u> <u>mits otherwise</u>. Archbishop Schnurr has determined that whether concealed handguns are permitted in any church building is left to the discretion of the pastor of the church. This authorization from the pastor <u>must be a written authoriza-</u> <u>tion</u> and given only to an individual with a CCW

Permit and only to meet a security need.
