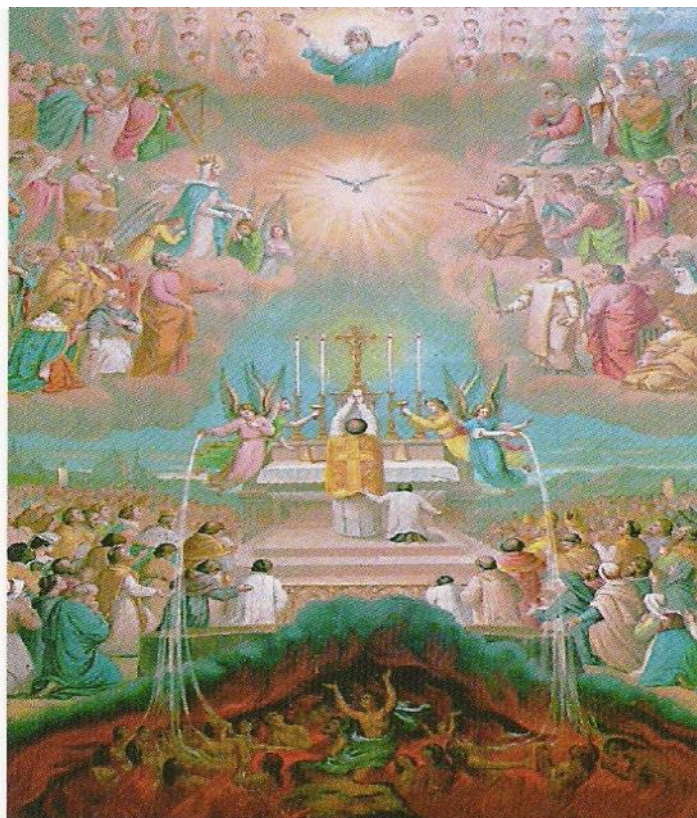

Concealed Carry Policy state/archdiocese/Parish

Regarding Church Buildings: The Ohio State law provides that **a concealed handgun may not be carried into any church or other place of worship unless the church or other place of worship permits otherwise.** Archbishop Schnurr has determined that whether concealed handguns are permitted in any church building is left to the discretion of the pastor of the church. This authorization from the pastor **must be a written authorization** and given only to an individual with a CCW Permit and only to meet a security need.
