"Render to Caesar what belongs to Caesar but render to God what belongs to God!"

In today's Gospel Jesus reminds us that yes indeed we must honor rightful authority. In doing so we obey the 4th Commandment for "honor thy father and mother" includes all rightful authority over us both civil and religious. All authority comes from God. Our Lord told Pilate "You would have no power over me unless it were given you from above". We get the leaders we deserve! We OWE obedience to those in authority over us except for sin!
