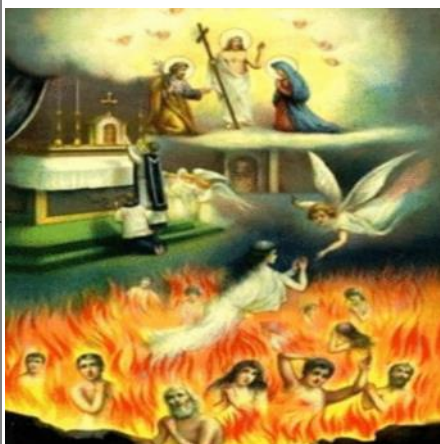

Security Guard On Duty

With the recent Archdiocesan Insurance inspection we have been working to develop a Safety Policy. Besides the restricted CCW Policy already announced and published we are also working on an Active Shooter Policy as well. From our own parishioners and from other FSSP apostolates we have determined that an armed security guard in the parking lot is the first deterrent. We also have heard that “when seconds count the police will be there in minutes”. We have been told the safety team will most likely be used more often for medical emergencies than an active shooter but it is good to “Be Prepared!”

A family has offered to help pay the cost for the new security guard.

Abortion Clinic Update—BAD NEWS FOR BABIES!

The Ohio Department of Health under the leadership of new Director Amy Acton, a placement by the DeWine administration, has re-licensed one of the most prolific abortion facilities in our state. As of today, the Women’s Med Center has been re-licensed to perform surgical abortions, though their former license revocation appeal process was just denied weeks ago. This is the second time the Ohio Department of Health has acted as plaintiff in successful court cases that have shut down 2 Ohio abortion facilities, only to re-license these same facilities weeks later.

“We are completely dismayed and disgusted with the Ohio Department of Health’s inability to revoke a license and then stand by that decision. Abortion facilities continue to make a mockery of this Department and Ohio taxpayers. Taxpayers should truly question how their money is being spent fighting appeals, in this case for 3 years--only to have to have a new license put in place weeks later.” States Margie Christie, Executive Director of Dayton Right to Life.

In 2018, Women’s Med Center killed over 2,800 children at its Kettering location. Since 2000, over 47,000 abortions have taken place at this facility, making it one of the most prolific abortuaries in our state’s history.
