**********PALM SUNDAY*********



Believe it or not today is Palm Sunday. It is hard to believe because we will not have the blessing or distribution of palms before the mass since they are indeed a source by which the Covid 19 virus could spread. Yet regardless of what we can and cannot do liturgically Holy Mother Church will still enter into the mystery of the life of Our Lord that transcend both time and space. Since He is an infinite being He is transcendent. He again enters Jerusalem today as He did some 2000 years ago triumphant yet humble. riding on an ass. The people proclaim Him king amid shout Hosanna to the Son of David, a title He rightfully claims. However, even today we still see that fickle crowd that one minute declares Him king yet in less than a week turn on their king and shout "Crucify Him, Crucify Him!" we ourselves have done this if we have ever committed a mortal sin. Even venial sins are a slap to His face. Let us recall that what happened in the past in Jerusalem and what the Church celebrates today is a foreshadowing of the future when He will enter into that New Jerusalem and reign as King forever. Let us therefore open our hearts to Him and welcome Him, our King who has conquered sin and death, into our souls!
