Sunday After The Ascension

The 9 days from Ascension Thursday to Pentecost Sunday is depicted as the first Novena of the Church called by Jesus Himself as we read in Acts 1:4-5 "and while eating with them He charged them not to depart from Jerusalem but to wait for the promise of the Father 'of which you have heard' said He 'by my mouth for John indeed baptized with water but you shall be baptized by the Holy Spirit not many days hence." The apostles did as Our Lord asked and perhaps having learned an important lesson from their big mistake at the Garden of Gethsemane PRAYED CONSTANTLY those nine days in the Upper Room.
