HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY!



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity which expresses the dogma that in the One God there are three Divine Persons, Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Today St Paul exclaims to the Romans and to US: *"Oh the depths of the riches of the wisdom and of the knowledge of God! How in comprehensible are His judgements and how unsearchable His ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been His counsellor?"* Although this is a mystery we are able to believe it without error because God has indeed revealed it to us. St. Thomas Aquinas explains this Mystery in the Summa Theologica, Ia, q7-43. He also shows us it is reasonable to believe that the Creator God is far beyond what we as creatures know or understand and it is unreasonable to not believe what Our Almighty, All knowing and All Loving God has revealed to us!
