FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Today's Scripture, the Word of God, reminds us to avoid anger and practice the virtue of charity. In the epistle, 1Pet3:8-15, St Peter exhorts us to "Be all like minded in prayer, compassionate...not rendering evil for evil or abuse for abuse but contrariwise, blessing for unto this were you called that you might inherit a blessing" Our first Pope, the Vicar of Christ, certainly lived what he preached for St. Peter willingly laid down his life for Christ.

In the Gospel, MT 5:20-24, Our Lord Himself informs us "Unless your justice exceeds that of the Pharisees you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven." The lesson for today is therefore very important! It is no longer "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth" as was the Old Law of Moses. By the New Law of Christ we must imitate Him who even on the cross said "Father, forgive them". He also tells us to Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you and pray for those who revile you." (Luke 6:27-28). He has taught us not only by word but most importantly by example that we must avoid anger. We must not be overcome by evil but overcome evil with good. This true charity MUST be in us if we are going to make it to heaven. Let us therefore ask for an increase of charity that loves God above all things and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God!

MASS OF THE AGES

This documentary on the latin Mass is well in the making. It is being directed by parishioner Cameron O'Hearn who has so graciously assisted us with the Livestreaming of the Mass and then projecting the Sunday Mass down into the Parish hall basement for the overflow crowds due to the social distancing by the Covid pandemic.
