## The Good Samaritan

**“What must I do to obtain eternal life?” This is the question asked by the lawyer in today’s gospel. In our secular world many deny the reality of eternal life and the fact that there is indeed an Almighty, Creator God. What are they living for? Let us recall our first catechism lesson: “What is the purpose of man’s existence?” The answer of course is : “ The purpose for our existence is to know, love and serve God in this life so we can be happy with Him forever in the next!” How sad that so many people do not know this fundamental answer. What is their purpose?
