ALL SAINTS DAY



Last Sunday we celebrated the Feast of Christ the King. Now that we have honored the Head of the Mystical Body of Christ we now honor on this Feast of All Saints, all the holy men and women, our brothers and sisters in Christ, who presently enjoy the beatific vision.
