As you can tell by the altar flowers, rose vestments and the rose candle burning in the Advent Wreath, today is Gaudete Sunday. "Gaudete" is the Latin imperative form of the verb "to rejoice". "Rejoice in the Lord always again I say rejoice". Quite astonishing are these words from today's epistle

when we realize that St. Paul wrote them from a prison cell in Rome! The joy St. Paul urges the Philippians-and us today—to practice is the spiritual joy which comes from the knowledge that as Catholics we are incorporated into the Mystical Body of Christ whose present gifts of grace and promise of future glory are sufficient at all times to secure a ready and joyful acceptance of God's will in adversity as well as prosperity. St. Paul rejoices in prison because his chains have turned out to be the means of spreading the Gospel to others and therefore a means to his own salvation as well. We rejoice today because the preparation time called Advent will soon be over and the celebration will soon begin!! The Christ Child is coming! Are you ready?

Armor of God Rosary Processions


