## FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



“...we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption as sons, the redemption of our body, in Christ Jesus our Lord” (Rom8:23). In today’s epistle St. Paul reminds us that through Jesus taking on our humanity in order to redeem us and through the power of the Holy Ghost, the Sanctifier, we are able to become adopted children of God!
