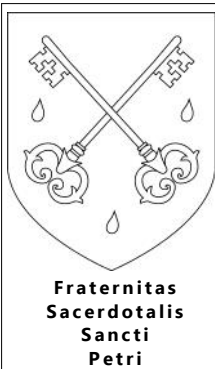

CONSECRATION TO THE IMMACULATE HEART



TODAY, August 15th, is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary body and soul into heaven! BLESSING OF HERBS TODAY AT 10:30 Mass

There is a special blessing of herbs and fruit on the Feast of the Assumption by which the Church celebrates a harvest festival with this sacramental. With each Hail Mary we say "and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus" A table will be set up by the Blessed Mothers altar for herbs & fruit to be placed on BEFORE the 10:30. Mass. The blessing takes place after the asperges so it will be done at the 10:30 High Mass. Let us thank Our Lady for our spiritual fruit!
