That others may become holier than I, provided that I may be-

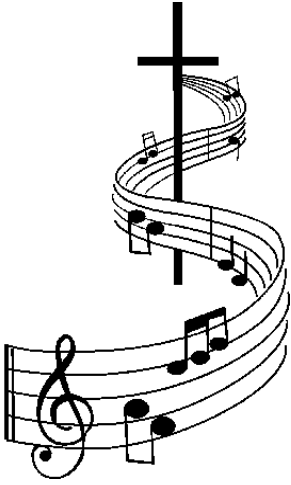
come as holy as I should...
