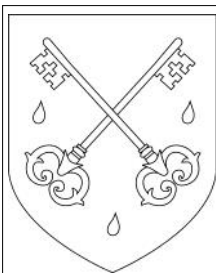

TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

“Render to Caesar what belongs to Caesar but render to God what belongs to God!” In today’s Gospel Jesus reminds us that yes indeed we must honor rightful authority. In doing so we obey the 4th Commandment for “honor thy father and mother” includes all rightful authority over us both civil and religious. All authority comes from God. Our Lord told Pilate “You would have no power over me unless it were given you from above”. We get the leaders we deserve! We OWE obedience to those in authority over us except for sin! Caesar’s power is not absolute.

But what do we owe God? His power IS ABSOLUTE over us! Let us recall That in the Book of Genesis we were made “in the image and likeness of God.” At baptism we were marked with the sign of the cross. At baptism an indelible mark was placed on our very soul even more permanent than the image of Caesar on the denarius. Therefore, let us truly render to God what belongs to God—our body, our soul our life and our very existence!
