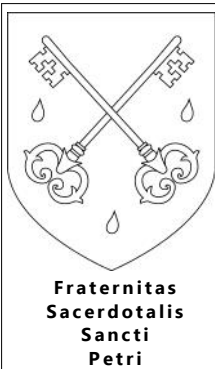

## Third Sunday of Advent/ Gaudete Sunday!



As you can tell by the altar flowers, rose vestments and the rose candle burning in the Advent Wreath, today is Gaudete Sunday. "Gaudete" is the Latin imperative form of the verb "to rejoice". "Rejoice in the Lord always again I say rejoice". Quite astonishing are these words from today's epistle when we realize that

St. Paul wrote them from a prison cell in Rome!

The joy St. Paul urges the Philippians—and us today—to practice is the spiritual joy which comes from the knowledge that as Catholics we are incorporated into the Mystical Body of Christ whose present gifts of grace and promise of future glory are sufficient at all times to secure a ready and joyful acceptance of God's will in adversity as well as prosperity. St. Paul rejoices in prison because his chains have turned out to be the means of spreading the Gospel to others and therefore a means to his own salvation as well. We rejoice today because the preparation time called Advent will soon be over! The Christ Child is coming! Are you ready??

Dec 12th Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe  
Patroness of the Unborn!



Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared in Mexico as the pregnant Mother of God to Blessed Juan Diego, an Aztec Indian, on December 9, 10, and 12, 1531. She left a Miraculous Image of her appearance on his cactus fiber cloak, or tilma, which still exists today for all to see in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City.

Our Lady came to offer faith, hope and consolation to the oppressed natives of Mexico and to reconcile them with their Spanish rulers by asking a church be built. She put an end to the bloody human sacrifice of the Aztecs and converted ten million natives in the next 10 years!

Let us ask Our Lady of Guadalupe to intercede for the unborn of the United States who are sacrificed by their own mothers to the great goddess of "choice"

When we fall into despair and seem to have lost all hope let us recall the words she said to Little Juan Diego -AND TO US - on Tepeyac Hill

*"Listen and let it penetrate your heart my dear little Child. Do not be troubled or weighed down with grief. Do not fear any illness or vexation, anxiety or pain. Am I not here who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not your fountain of life? Are you not in the folds of my mantle? In the crossing of my arms? Is there anything else you need?"*
