Plenary Indulgences!

Holy Mother Church sees the end of the year and the beginning of a new one as so important that she grants a plenary indulgence, remission of ALL temporal punishment (purgatory time) due to sins already confessed, under the usual conditions CONFESSION)20 days before/after Holy Communion, Prayers for the Pope (Our Father & Hail Mary) and Detachment from all sins, by publicly singing or praying the "Te Deum" on the last day of the year, Dec. 31st, at the NOON MASS and/or the "Veni Creator" on the first day of the year, Jan. 1st at either Feast Day Mass.

IS JAN. 1ST 2022 A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION ?
The Octave Day of Christmas, formally known as the Feast of the Circumcision & now in the universal Church as the Solemnity of Mary, unfortunately falls on a Saturday this year. It has been dispensed in the USA. HOWEVER, traditional Catholics will attend regardless of the obligation for the love of the Baby Jesus and His Mother and especially because WE NEED THE GRACES!!!
Do not complain if 2022 is a worse year than 2021 if you do not ask God's mercy upon us and simply give Him the First Day of the new year!!
