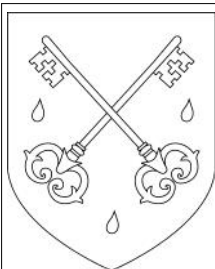

## Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus

Today we celebrate this feast which recalls to our mind who this Child is: "Jesus" means "God saves" in Hebrew. We are also reminded by St Paul in Phil. 2:10-11 "At the name of Jesus every knee should bend of those in heaven, on earth and under the earth". We were taught in elementary school to bow our heads every time we hear that Holy

Name of Jesus. Since it belongs to the Second Person of the Trinity it has great power. Our Lord Himself told us "whatever you ask the Father IN MY NAME He will give it to you" Jn 16:23. The Holy Name is powerful for it designates the mystery, the power and the mission of the Son of Man who came to save us. To call upon His Holy Name is to appeal to the infinite merits of His passion, death and resurrection. 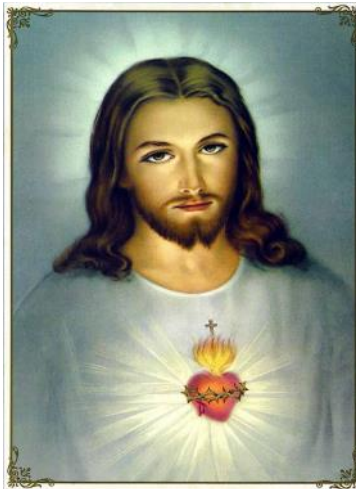
**(excerpts from the letter to Fr. Gabet**
