The Fourth Sunday of Lent—Laetare Sunday

As is evident by the rose colored vestments—today is Laetare Sunday. "Laetare" is the imperative form of the Latin verb which means "rejoice". It is the first word of the introit of today's Mass which reads:

"Rejoice, O Jerusalem and come together all you who love her. Rejoice you who have been in sorrow that you may exalt and be filled from the abundance of your consolation." (Isaia 66-10-11)

In today's liturgy we find the spirit of joy in the

midst of penance. We find a rose amidst the prickly thorns of fasting, sacrifice AND A **BLOODY WAR IN UKRAINE AND OTHER** SUFFERINGS!
