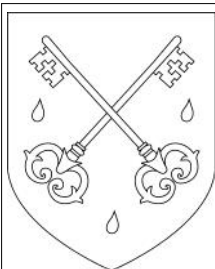

SEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

How appropriate the Sacred Scriptures are for us today during this time after Pentecost 2022. -Has the coming of the Holy Ghost into our souls brought forth any good fruit? Have we grown in our faith or have we fallen backwards? St Paul admonishes us in the Epistle, Romans 6:19-23, "But now set free from sin and be slaves to God, you have your fruit unto sanctification and as your end life everlasting. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is life everlasting in Christ Jesus our Lord". In the gospel our Lord gives us the warning: "Every tree that does not bear fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Therefore by their fruits you shall know them. Not everyone who says to me "Lord, Lord" shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of my Father in heaven shall enter the kingdom of heaven." Let us ask ourselves today "Am I doing the will of my Father?" "Am I bearing good fruit?" "Can I do More?" Remember just because we are Catholics -yes even traditional Catholics-does not mean we are going to heaven! Let us do the Father's will!

We can ask the same thing of our nation. Are we bringing forth good fruit? Lately we hear again and again of active shootings : in an elementary school in Uvalde, TX, in a grocery store in Buffalo and in a shopping mall near Indianapolis. All of them young men who have nothing else to live for! They want their names on the news because it is the only thing that makes them feel alive. But we must ask ourselves if a woman has a right to end the life of her own baby, if she can choose whether another unique person with 46 chromosomes (only half from the mother) never seen before and will never be seen again, made in the image and likeness of God must die so she can live as she wants, why can't I choose who lives or dies? We definitely reap what we sow! Will America finally turn from the culture of death and call upon God and respect His laws again?

Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord!!
