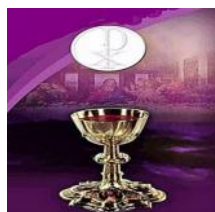

Passion Sunday

As you noticed by the statues veiled in violet today we enter into what is traditionally known as Passiontide. From Septuagesima Holy Mother Church has called us to follow Our Lord's footsteps in the course of His apostolic ministry. Now in Passiontide, she is clad in mourning and veiled in purple as she contemplates the sorrowful events of the last two weeks of Our Redeemer's mortal life. During Passiontide Psalm 42 and the doxology (Gloria Patri...) is omitted in the prayers at the foot of the altar for masses of the season. This is done to bring out the Church's sadness of the suffering of Our Lord which now becomes intense as His Passion and death nears.

In the Gospel Our Lord's situation with the Pharisees and Scribes is certainly becoming more intense. He calls them liars and they take up stones to kill Him and so He hides Himself and departs from the temple. How ironic since the temple was built for God yet the Son of God, Jesus, is not welcome in His own home!

Is this not what we have done when we commit sin, especially mortal sin which drives Jesus out of our souls? During Passiontide, the last two weeks of Lent let us open our hearts and our souls to Jesus by making a good examination of conscience and a sincere and contrite confession. Welcome Jesus back into His holy temple which is your soul! Let us also make our fasting & prayers more intense as we accompany Jesus to His cross!

HOLY SATURDAY TENEBRAE!



Tenebrae is the Latin word meaning “darkness”. As we enter into the Passion and death of Our Lord we experience with Him the spiritual darkness of a world of sin. Our Lord, sinless Himself, enters into the darkness with His Passion and Death. Tenebrae is the public chanting of the Divine Office, the official prayer of the Church, specifically Matins and Laudes.

The chants are from the Lamentations of the prophet Jeremiah and the psalms with the intent of penitence. The ceremony, although lasting three hours is quite simple. It consists of extinguishing 14 candles on a triangular candleholder called the Tenebrae Hearse while leaving the 15th white candle burning at the apex of the hearse. This candle symbolizes Christ the light of the world in anticipation of His resurrection at the Easter Vigil. The Tenebrae Hearse here at Holy Family was made in Oberammergau, Germany the site of the Passion Play and the home of the greatest woodcraftsmen in the world! It was anonymously donated to the FSSP by benefactors of Holy Family!! This will be the first time for us to sing Tenebrae. Everyone is welcome to come join us! Latin /English translations will be available at the door. **IT WILL LAST THREE HOURS! BEGINNING AT 7AM HOLY SAT.**
