

FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



"...we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption as sons, the redemption of our body, in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Rom8:23). In today's epistle St. Paul reminds us that through Jesus taking on our humanity in order to redeem us and through the power of the Holy Ghost, the Sanctifier, we are able
