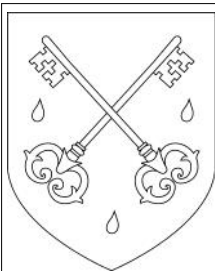

TWENTY FIRST SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Today's Gospel is the parable where the King forgives the debt of one of his servants, having mercy on him, yet that servant upon coming across a fellow servant who owed him money throttled him demanding payment. When he could not pay, even though the king had forgiven his debt, he had his fellow servant thrown into prison. Once the king hears of this he becomes angry with the first servant and hands him over to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him. Jesus ends the parable by saying "So also my heavenly Father will do to you, if you do not forgive your brothers from your hearts."

Our lesson for today is that God is indeed merciful—infinitely merciful! There is no sin He cannot forgive as long as we are sorry and ask forgiveness. However, He expects that we have mercy on others! "Blessed are the merciful for they shall obtain mercy" as we read in the beatitudes. In Our Lord's prayer, the one HE taught us, which hopefully we say everyday as the Our Father, we set the limits on how much we want to be forgiven by how much we forgive others. "Forgive us our trespasses AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US."

Our Lord has been so good to us forgiving our debt which we could NEVER repay on our own. All the gold and silver in the world could not buy the forgiveness of even the slightest sin. "Know that you were not redeemed with corruptible things as gold and silver...but with the Precious Blood of Christ, as of a lamb unspotted and undefiled" (1Peter 18-19). On the cross Our Lord, the Innocent One, gave us the example by praying even for those who caused His passion and His terrible torture upon that cross by saying "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." God has been so good to us forgiving a debt we could never repay—original sin, mortal sin and venial sin—let us therefore be merciful to others!! Remember the ABC's of Divine Mercy!! A: ask for mercy B: be merciful C: confidence—trust in God's mercy
